

Admission Policy and Procedure

Admission Policy

Our Shepherd Lutheran School admits students of any race, color, religion, national or ethnic origin, or socio-economic background to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students of the school. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, national or ethnic origin, or socio-economic status in administration or educational policies, admission policies, and athletic and other school administered programs.

Admission Procedure

Parents are encouraged to visit Our Shepherd while classes are in session, talk with the principal, and ask questions before applying for admission. Appointments can be made by calling the school office at 317-271-9100. Prospective students are also encouraged to visit the school's open houses. The number of students accepted is dependent on the number of current students returning. Open enrollment begins February 16th. New students will be accepted until all available spaces are filled. On a case-by-case basis, students may be admitted after the start of the school year.

Admission to Preschool, Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten

In order for enrollment to be granted at Our Shepherd Lutheran School at these levels, the child's birthday must be before September 1 for the corresponding year of school (3 years old for Preschool, 4 years old for Pre-Kindergarten, 5 years old for Kindergarten)

Admission to Grades One through Eight

In order for enrollment to be granted at Our Shepherd Lutheran School at these grade levels, the following need to be completed: (Applications are accepted but enrollment is not granted until the following is met)

1. Parent interview with the principal
2. Grade transcripts from previous school received
3. Enrollment fee paid
